<b>Notes:</b>	Redshift is a GPU-accelerated, biased rendering engine that integrates with host 3D applications via plugins. It does not implement standard platform accessibility APIs (MSAA, UI Automation, NSAccessibility). Evaluation was performed via manual testing based on product knowledge and the published Redshift user guide.
